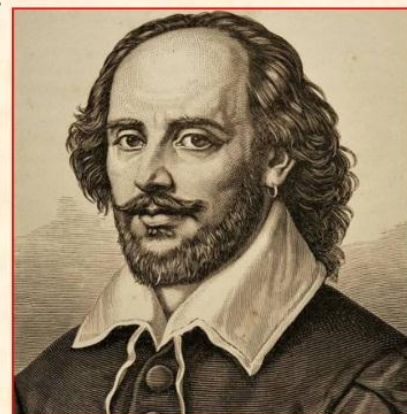
About College
