A report of Student Satisfaction Survey (2020-2023)


A survey has been conducted to know how far the students of Ranaghat College are satisfied with the existing system and academic environment of the college. The survey has been made to find out the impression and suggestion of learners for the last three years i.e. from 2020 to 2023 regarding the academic approach and other learner-centric activities. Their rating of twenty one items is quite satisfactory. It has been found that a considerable number of learners are satisfied with the prevailing conditions and activities of the institute. So far as coverage of syllabus and proficiency of teachers are concerned, more than 70% of learners have expressed their satisfaction and 20% of them have found them to be excellent. In case of effective teaching almost all learners find it to be satisfactory. None has any grievance regarding the evaluation process followed in internal examinations. 14.6% students have pointed out that the performance of students in examinations has been always discussed and some ways have been suggested for improvement. Most of the learners are of the view that the performance is analyzed very often. 34.4% of learners have found the teaching and monitoring process followed in college is conducive to their cognitive, social and emotional growth and most of the learners have expressed their satisfaction regarding the process. More than 50% of learners have agreed that the institute has provided them many opportunities for their multifaceted growth. A considerable number of learners have expressed their view that they have been informed properly and timely about the program outcomes and course outcomes and they are also satisfied with the mentoring process. 28.6% of learners are found to be extremely satisfied with the ways teachers have adopted in the classroom and illustrated various concepts through examples and applications. In this regard, the response of 32.6% learners is moderate. 55% of learners are of the view that teachers have helped them to know their strength and weakness and given them relevant suggestion to go ahead in their activities and career. 28.4% of learners have strongly agreed that they are always encouraged to keep up the overall quality improvement and make a review of it from time to time. The response of 23.6% learners is moderate and none has any grievance about it. Learners are found to be satisfied with the student-oriented approach and method adopted by teachers in curriculum delivery. During survey, the response of 28.7% learners as regards the institute's encouragement to experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies is found to be moderate. So far as extracurricular activities are concerned, 54% learners have expressed satisfaction and 32 % of them remain neutral in their response. Responding to the efforts of the institute for the development soft skills of learners for the sake of their employability during survey, 52% learners have expressed satisfaction and only 7% of them are found to be dissatisfied in this regard. Although a considerable number of students have found the use of ICT tools by teachers in course of imparting lessons to be adequate, 16% of them have pointed out the insufficient use of ICT. The overall quality of teaching-learning process has provided utmost satisfaction to 29% learners of the institute and 26% of them have also found it to be satisfactory. It is quite encouraging to teachers that none has grievance in this regard. Finally, a large number of learners have expressed

satisfaction over the blended mode of teaching adopted by teachers, though 14% of them have expressed dissatisfaction in this regard.


Learners have taken keen interest in completing survey in time and it has helped the stakeholders of college a lot to assess the strength and weakness of the institute.











Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme
















