



Event Report

Event: Distribution of Shreyashi Bose Memorial Scholarship & Speech Contest

Venue: Department of English, Ranaghat College

Date; 30th August, 2022

Description of Event: A scholarship was launched by Department of English in 2020 in memory of Smt Shreyashi Bose, a faculty of the department, who had died untimely a few years ago. The donation was made by the family of Smt. Bose to college for the purpose of scholarship. In accordance with the decision of the departmental teachers, the scholarship is given to the student of Department of English who secures the highest marks among the students of his batch in college in the final examination of English Honours conducted by University of Kalyani. The distribution of Shreyashi Bose Memorial Scholarship was made on 30th August 2022. The ceremony of distribution of scholarship started at 12.30 p.m. with the lighting of the lamp and commemoration of late Shreyashi Bose. It was attended by the Principal of college, Dr. Arup Kumar Maity, President of Governing Body, Dr. Jyoti Prakash Ghosh, a special guest related to late Shreyashi Bose, the members of teaching staff of Department of English and other departments and students of the department of English. The Head of the Department of English, Dr. Arunoday Mukherjee welcomed the guests and others in the beginning. The Principal, the President of GB, departmental teachers and other members of teaching staff of different departments commemorated the valuable service of Late Shreyashi Bose. Thereafter, the names of recipients of Shreyashi Bose Memorial Scholarship were announced. The recipients of scholarship included Sri Sudip Dasgupta, Miss Mouktika Pal and Sri Kunal Kundu who secured the highest marks in the final examination of English Honours in 2020, 2021 and 2022. The scholarship could not be distributed in the previous years because of lockdown. The Principal, Head of Department of English and the special guest present on the occasion distributed the scholarship to students and thanked them for their achievements.

After the distribution of scholarship, a speech contest in English was held on the topic *Fifty Years of Independence of India: Expectations and Fulfillment*. Many enthusiastic students of Department of English participated in the contest. The performance of the departmental students was satisfactory. They tried their level best to present their thoughts and ideas in English during the contest. The pronunciation and presentation of students was judged by Prof. Parimal Mondal of Department of English and Prof. Santanu Ger of Department of Philosophy. At the end of the contest, the students who secured First, Second and Third position in the Speech Contest were rewarded.
